Purpose:

• Tree planting to reduce forest fragmentation and increase forest cover by creating wildlife corridors.

Category Guidelines:

- Plantings larger than 1 hectare or 1000 trees must be stamped by a Registered Professional Forester.
- Plantings larger than 1 hectare will meet a reforestation rate of 800 trees/acre.
- Livestock must be restricted from the project area.
- All necessary permits/permissions must be obtained before planting.

Eligible Projects:

- Upland woodland reforestation, wildlife corridor creation/restoration.
- Slough forest restoration/pit and mound restoration.
- Replanting previously NPCA planted sites that have failed to achieve a 70% survival rate.

Eligible Costs:

- Contractor labour and planting services.
- Site preparation.
- Plant material.
- Cold storage costs.
- Delivery costs.
- Registered Professional Forester stamp
- Temporary fencing to restrict livestock access.
- NPCA Administrative costs- Project management, project implementation, planting plan design, site supervision.

Ineligible Costs:

- Maintenance costs incurred after the establishment of plant material.
- Relocation of established trees.
- Establishment of trees or shrubs that are intended for harvesting for economic benefit (i.e., Christmas trees, nurseries, etc.).
- Caliper-sized trees.
- Landowner labour costs.
- Non-NPCA administrative costs Project management, survival assessments, planting plan design, site supervision.

Key Performance Indicators:

- Trees planted
- Shrubs planted
- Hectares reforested
