

Binbrook Conservation Area **2018 Season - Controlled Waterfowl Hunting**

The Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority (NPCA) is pleased to offer the Controlled Waterfowl Hunt at Binbrook Conservation Area for another year.

For the 2018 waterfowl season, hunting will be offered at Binbrook Conservation Area **on Mondays and Saturdays from September 22 through December 8, 2018** (during unfrozen lake conditions and excluding Thanksgiving Monday). All hunting is from ten designated hunting blinds, and a lottery/draw will be held to reserve hunting blinds for the first two weeks of the waterfowl season.

The fees and lottery draw in effect include:

- i) hunting fees at \$40 + tax /blind/day (maximum of 2 people per blind)
- ii) a lottery/draw to reserve the use of hunting blinds for the first two weeks of the season (September 22 through October 1). Failure to pay will result in loss of lottery eligibility in 2018
- iii) a lottery/draw to reserve the use of hunting blind #5 from October 6 through December 8, 2018
- iv) Prepayment is required by Visa, or Mastercard. Payment is charged to the credit card only when an individual is drawn for a hunting blind
- v) all hunting blind(s) payments are non-refundable
- vi) a hunting harvest report must be completed and returned to the gatehouse at the end of each hunting day to remain eligible for the 2019 hunting lottery
- vii) **a boat is required for all hunting blinds.** Boat rental is available on site should you need it
- viii) **Hunting Blind Registration and Access** from 5 a.m. to 6 a.m. only. Hunting until 12 noon. **Park Gate** closes sharply at 1 p.m.

Mud Lake Conservation Area 2018 Season - Controlled Waterfowl Hunting

The Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority (NPCA) is pleased to be offering the Controlled Waterfowl Hunt at Mud Lake Conservation Area again this year.

For the 2018 waterfowl season, hunting will be offered **on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays** from 3 designated hunting blinds at the site.

The fees and lottery/ draw in effect for this year include:

- i) no fee for hunting blind this year
- ii) a lottery/draw will be held to reserve the use of hunting blinds for the first two weeks of the duck season (September 22 through October 5, 2018)
- iii) a NPCA hunting permit is required to hunt at this site. As part of this permission a hunting harvest report must be completed and received at the NPCA office by December 31, 2018. Failure to return the report will result in loss of hunting eligibility for 2019
- iv) retriever dog platforms are provided on all 3 hunting blinds

To be included in the lottery/draw, please complete the ballot below and **return** it by mail, email, facsimile, or in person, to our office no later than **August 31, 2018**. All applicants will be notified of results by regular mail/ email.

Please note hunting times will be posted at the site. They will be approximately ½ hour AFTER sunrise to ½ BEFORE sunset per NPCA policies. Should you require any additional information please contact Kim Frohlich at (905) 788-3135 ext. 241.

*NOTE: Please visit the site beforehand to check site conditions. From October 6, 2018 onwards hunting blinds are on a first come-first served basis.
