SUMMER 2020 ADVENTURE day camps

FOREST EXPLORERS

JUNE 29 - JULY 3 / JULY 27 - 31

JULY 6 - 10

Journey back in time to the village of Glen Elgin during pioneer times. Campers will embark on a mission to help our villagers live and thrive without modern conveniences! Campers will forge tools in the blacksmith shop, grind their own flour in the grist mill, tend to the gardens, and make a treat in the brick bake oven. SUMMER SURVIVORS

JULY 13 - 17 / AUGUST 10 - 14

Have you got what it takes to survive the wild and the natural local elements? Campers will learn to navigate through the forest, build shelters and fires, and discover the bounty of the environment around them! Working in teams to complete the ultimate survivor challenge, campers will make use of their newly acquired archery, emergency signaling, and water purifying skills and abilities.

WET AND WILD

JULY 20 - 24 / AUGUST 17 - 21

Dive into the world of wetlands and wildlife at Ball's Falls! Take a dip into aquatic life with pond and stream studies, meet the reptiles, amphibians and insects that call the creek home, and traverse the trails looking for important species and their habitats. Campers will learn about water conservation, build their own wetlands and participate in water relay races.
