

## **Binbrook Conservation Area** **2022 Season - Controlled Waterfowl Hunting**

The Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority (NPCA) is pleased to offer the Controlled Waterfowl Hunt at Binbrook Conservation Area for another year.

For the 2021 waterfowl season, hunting will be offered at Binbrook Conservation Area **on Saturdays** from **September 24 through December 10, 2022** (during unfrozen lake conditions and excluding Thanksgiving Monday). All hunting is **from nine designated hunting blinds**, and a lottery/draw will be held to reserve hunting blinds for the first two weeks of the waterfowl season.

The fees and lottery draw in effect include:

- i) hunting fees at \$40 + tax /blind/day (maximum of 2 people per blind)
- ii) a lottery/draw to reserve the use of hunting blinds for the first and second week of the season (September 24 and October 1). Failure to pay will result in loss of lottery eligibility in 2023
- iii) Prepayment is required by Visa, or Mastercard. Payment is charged to the credit card only when an individual is drawn for a hunting blind
- iv) all hunting blind(s) payments are non-refundable
- v) a hunting harvest report must be completed and returned to the gatehouse at the end of each hunting day to remain eligible for the 2023 hunting lottery
- vi) a **boat is required for all hunting blinds**. Boat rental is available on site should you need it
- vii) **Hunting Blind Registration and Access** from 5 a.m. to 6 a.m. only. Hunting until 12 noon. **Park Gate** closes sharply at 1 p.m.
- viii) subject to changes
- ix) must comply with public health regulations

To submit your name for the lottery please complete the form below and **return** it by mail, email, facsimile, or in person, to the NPCA office no later than **August 31, 2022**. All successful applicants will be notified of the results by regular mail/email.
