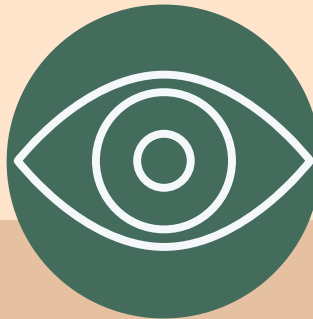

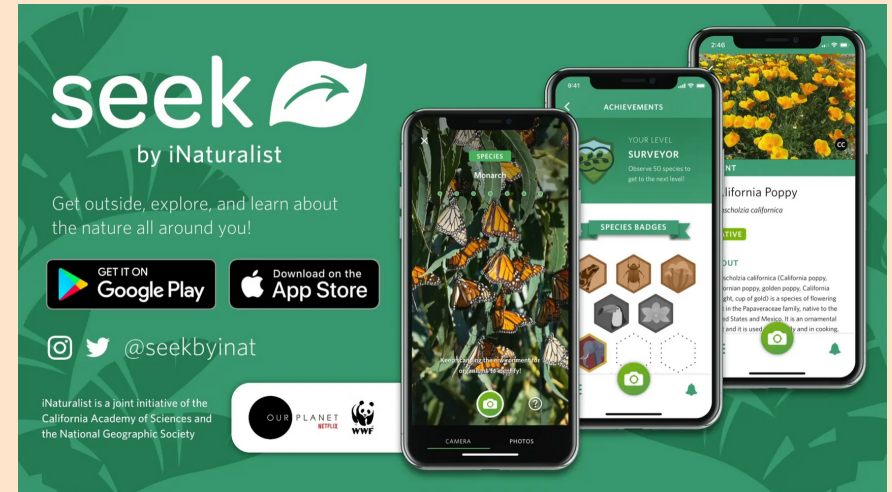

If your pet is anything like mine, they LOVE watching wildlife out the window! Why not turn this into an amazing learning opportunity?!



Procedure

1. Have your kids identify the outdoor animals your pet is looking at. If yours or their animal ID skills aren't that great, use an app like SEEK by iNaturalist to help you out!
2. Tally the number of times your pet sees that animal.
3. After a period of time of observing all the animals your pet sees, determine how each animal made them feel.
4. For example, seeing sparrows makes my cat happy but European starlings make her angry
